Instructions with Dice:

1. Roll the dice and move the number shown on the dice.
2. If you land on a germ this is bad because you are now infected with a virus. So move back how many spaces it tells you to.
3. If you land on a Soap Bubble this is great because you are now germ free move forward as many spaces as it tells you to.
4. The game is finished when the first person crosses the finish line.

Instructions without Dice:

1. Find something that has two sides that you will be able to use as a dice. For example Bottle Cap. (Make sure you can tell the difference between the two sides).
2. Flip the bottle cap (the open side of the bottle cap will equal 2 spaces the closed side will equal 4 and if it lands on its side it equals 3) then move the amount you have flipped.
3. If you land on a germ this is bad because you are now infected with a virus. So move back how many spaces it tells you to.
4. If you land on a Soap Bubble this is great because you are now germ free move forward as many spaces as it tells you to.
5. The game is finished when the first person crosses the finish line.
